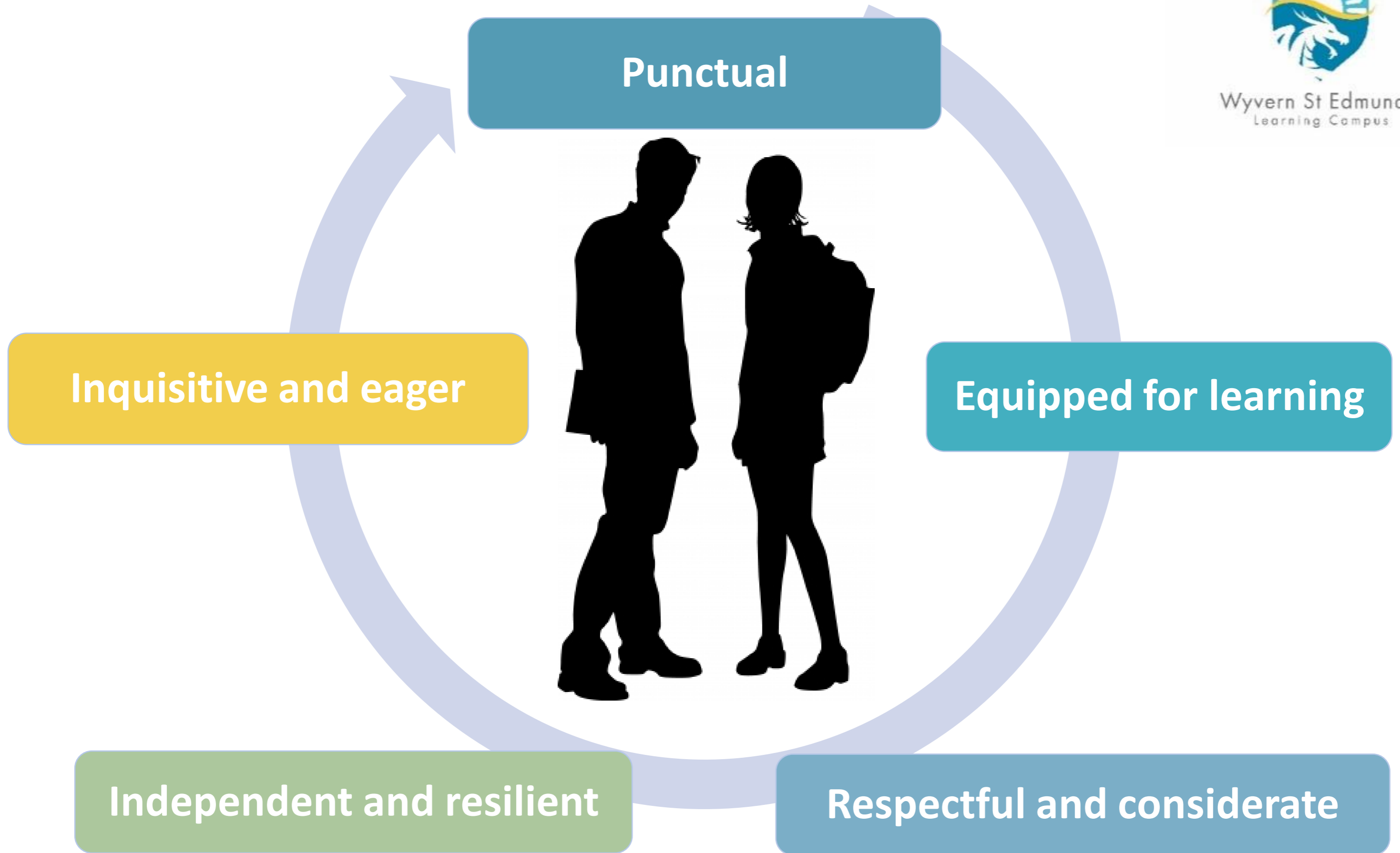

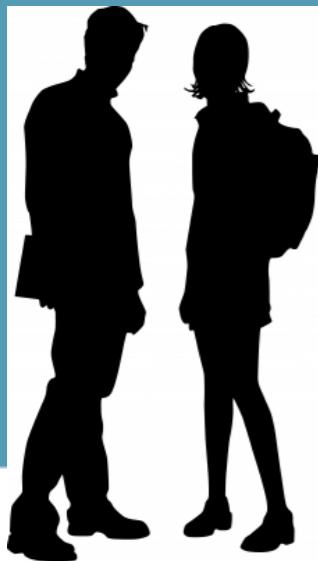

The WSE skills for life checklist:

Punctual

- I pack my bag myself before school
- I arrive in school on time

- I listen attentively to staff
